The Organizing Committee of Tokyo Art & Antiques is pleased to announce new information on the “2019 Tokyo Art & Antiques – Nihonbashi / Kyobashi Art Festival” held for three days – Thursday, April 25 to Saturday, April 27, in and around Tokyo’s Nihonbashi and Kyobashi district. We will be preparing an information base on th 27<sup>th</sup>(sat) at the ART & CRAFT MARKET @TOKYO SQUARE GARDEN and 24<sup>th</sup>(wed) to 28<sup>th</sup>(sun) at Nihonbashi Galeria Community Space along with workshop and sale of small craft works.

The programs for this year will include gallery talks, charity auction, tea ceremony event and workshops as well as the special exhibitions held by 56 galleries to entertain visitors.



The district of Nihonbashi / Kyobashi, in Tokyo's Chuo Ward, has been famous since the post-war era for its dealers in classical art, craft, Nihonga, modern painting, sculpture, prints and so on. Now, the district boasts around 150 such unique specialist galleries, making it second only to Ginza as Tokyo's preeminent arts zone. The “Tokyo Art & Antiques” first started as “Nihonbashi / Kyobashi Art & Antique Festival” in 1998, held once or twice every year. This will be the 10<sup>th</sup> year since the event was renamed to “Tokyo Art & Antiques” in 2010.

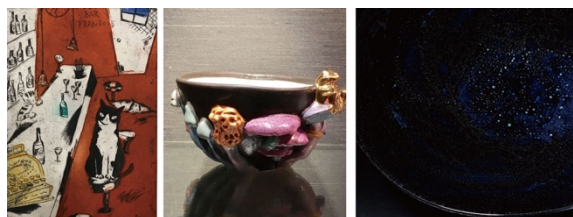

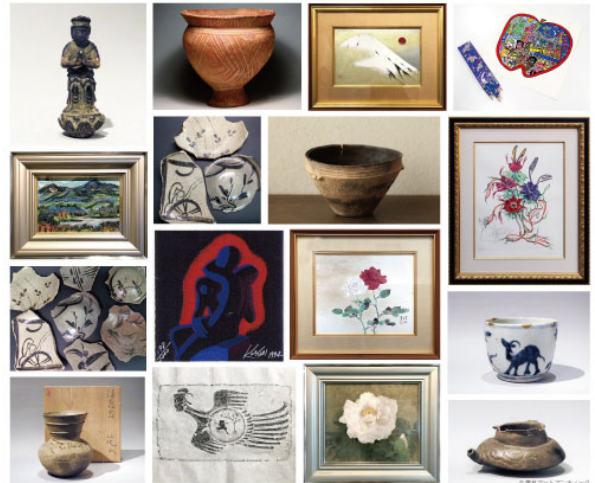
